1. THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) HAS NOW CONCLUDED A THREE DAY SEMINAR ON THE SUBJECT OF "PROBLEMS OF THE HISTORY OF THE USSR." ACCORDING TO AN EMBASSY SOURCE WHO ATTENDED ALL THE SESSIONS, THE SEMINAR INDICATED THE EXISTENCE OF A GULF BETWEEN THE PCI LEADERSHIP AND THE PARTY'S INTELLECTUALS IN EVALUATING THE HISTORICAL EVOLUTION OF THE SOVIET UNION. THE SOURCE SAID THAT CRITICISM OF SOVIET SOCIETY WAS MOST PRONOUNCED AMONG THE YOUNGER PCI INTELLECTUALS PRESENT.
